Columbian Exchange Project:

Choose one

Option 1:

Think about how the Columbian Exchange altered history. Was it worth it? Use three pieces of evidence from your research and write a three paragraph paper to support your answer. The reader should be able to identify your position, three pieces of evidence to back it up (along with citations, let's not plagiarize here) along with an explanation of how each piece of evidence supports your opinion.

Option 2:

Use your creativity to develop a small poster that shows three pros and cons of the Columbian Exchange. You should also advocate for a particular position, either the Exchange was a good thing, or a negative thing, or kind of in the middle. You can use pictures, text or a combination of both. You can complete this on paper or computer.

Option 3:

Create a 10 slide presentation explaining the causes, pros and cons, as well as the aftermath of the Columbian Exchange. You should have one or two slides that explain your opinion as well.

Option 4:

Use slides, poster, or an essay to compare the current situation of Coronavirus with the cons of the Columbian Exchange. What things are similar? Different? Choose a method to portray this information.
